

Introduction

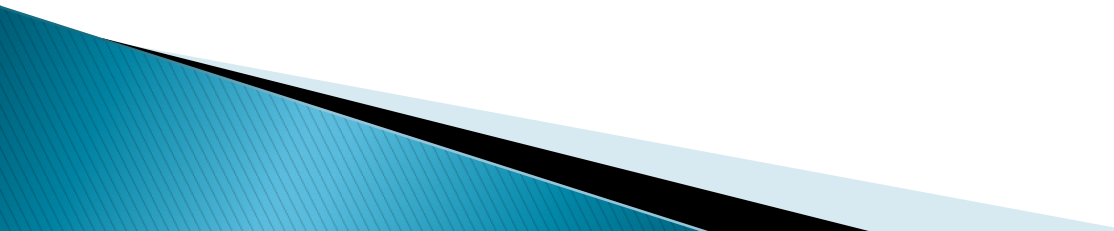
- ▶ One of the oldest Colleges in Malawi supported by Ministry of Health (MoH) through Christian Health association of Malawi (CHAM).
 - ▶ Training component at Malamulo was introduced in 1936 for allied health workers.
 - ▶ 2007 became constituent College of Malawi Adventist University (MAU)
 - ▶ In October 2012, degree programmes were introduced.
 - ▶ Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSc. PH) and Bachelor of Science in Medical Laboratory Science (BSc. MLS).



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
MISSION STATEMENT

- ▶ To train highly competent health professionals who are committed to provide quality health care while emulating Christ example, making a difference in the lives of communities in which they serve.
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
VISION

- ▶ The College has 832 students in total as presented in the next slide.



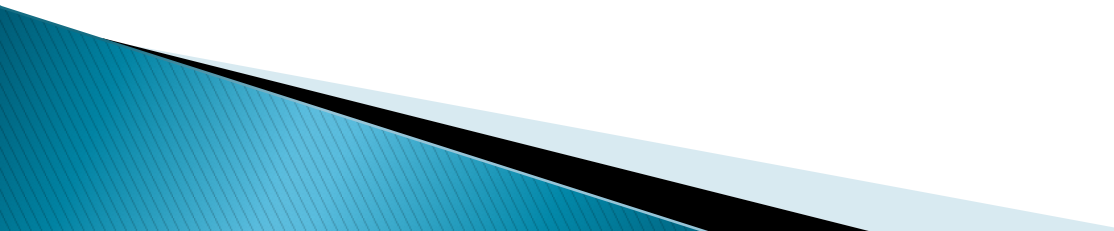
STAFF SITUATION

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



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ACTIVITIES


1. Proposal sent to Beit Trust to Construct 4 classroom blocks and four offices

- ▶ (d) Distribution of blankets at Winter project done in June 2018


FUTURE PLANS

1. To employ additional core staff
2. Planning to start BSc. in nursing and midwifery

CHALLENGES

1. With the increase in enrollment, the load of work is too much
 2. Erratic funding from our main stakeholders
 3. Lack of Tutor Housing – This problem is more serious to all departments. While these departments also increased the numbers of students, housing facilities have not increased, and tutors travel daily from distant places which lead to loss of man hours
 4. Incomplete hostel– discussions for the construction of a 320 bed capacity hostel between Malamulo College and CHAM completed
 5. Inadequate lecturers
 6. Inadequate classrooms

- ▶ The College is grateful to all its development partners and prays that they should continue doing so. As we can see, Malamulo College is trying to develop the institution apart from the challenges it is facing.
