- »45% of the population is <15 years</p>
- »Life Expectancy is55.9 Years
- »Health Expenditure
  7% of GDP
- »Access to some form of healthcare 50%

- »Physician Density
  - ~ 0.06 doctor /1,000
- »Bed Density
  - $\sim 0.7$  beds/ 1,000
- »Religion
  - ~ Christian- 56%
  - ~ Muslim- 18%
  - ~ Others- 26%
- »Official Language-Portuguese- 10%




