PROBLEM/NEED what are we trying to accomplish?

The social and health situation in the province of Lualaba in general and the town of Kolwezi in particular is generally precarious: life expectancy is 55 years and 60% of the population live below the poverty line. The town of Kolwezi has approximately 1,078,568 inhabitants spread over 2 municipalities. This health situation is characterized by a high prevalence of malaria, respiratory diseases aggravated by the occurrence of covid-19, high blood pressure, diabetes, cerebral vascular accidents, HIV infections, diarrheal diseases, verminosis, malnutrition. This constitutes a serious public health problem. The number of monthly consultations is around 10,883 new cases. There is also an average of 1,146 registrations for prenatal consultation, 379 deliveries per year, and 194 cases of surgical interventions. The main actions to achieve this effect will consist in improving the quality and quantity of health services offered, strengthening the health information system, and making competent human resources available. equipped with adequate equipment, with an infrastructure set to international standards and a good governance of this health establishment. It is therefore within this global framework that the Adventist Polyclinic of Kolwezi initiated this project to request support in equipment and materials in the fields of imaging, laboratory, operating room, hospitalization, maternity and resuscitation and support for the rehabilitation of polyclinic infrastructure.

Objective How will we know if a change is improving?

Global objective:

- sustainably improving access to health care as well as support for the population of Kolwezi by equipping the Polyclinic.
- Showing the love of Christ to the people of Kolwezi by providing quality care.

Specific objectives

- Equipping health infrastructures for the management of recurrent and chronic pathologies.
- Providing the Polyclinic with equipment and quality health products.
- participating in the city's health offer for the most vulnerable.

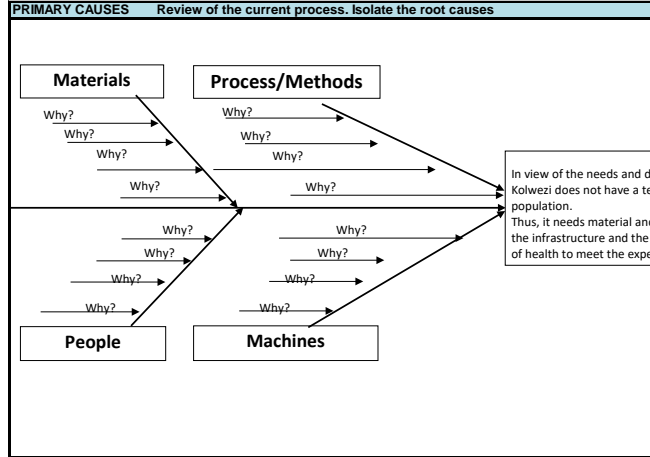
REFLEXION. What changes can we make that will lead to improvement?
