

AFRICA – Nursing Opportunities

Hospital: Blantyre Adventist Hospital, Malawi, Africa

Volunteers Needed: One or two LLUH nurses per service trip

When: A mutually agreed upon time

Length of Service: Two weeks or more

Requirements: Approximately three or more years of RN hospital experience (preferably with some ICU experience), BS degree. Nurses interested in hands-on teaching and mentoring. Participation in one or more pre-trip planning meetings.

Trip Objectives:

Assist with the continued training and education of ICU and ward nurses at Blantyre Adventist Hospital.

- Assess current protocols and training
- Provide hands-on and one-on-one mentoring
- Discuss practices and policies that could improve patient outcomes
- Provide continuing education presentation on specific nursing topic

Provided:

Blantyre Adventist Hospital = Room, lunch for days on service, airport transportation in Malawi
GHI = Short-term travel insurance, 50% reimbursement of visa and economy airfare when flight is procured through Butler Travel and travel is processed through GHI

Self = 50% of airfare and visa, US airport transportation, additional meals not mentioned, extracurricular excursions (i.e. safari, Lake Malawi trip, etc.)
